A Big Gusher at Noblesville. Special to the Indianapolis Journal.

Noblesville, Aug. 22.-The great gas well on the farm of William T. Wheeler, north of town, which is the fourteenth scccessful well in the Noblesville gas field, is beyond all question the strongest well in the Indiana gas field. gas, burning at the end of a six-inch pipe, blazes one hundred feet into the air, and illuminates the country for a radius of several miles with a brilliancy not attained by any other well. The light was seen distinctly from Lebanon, twentyfour miles distant. The volume of gas from this well so far exceeds that of other wells that a larger pipe than is ordinarily used for tubing will be necessary. The scene presented by night is one that can not be described, but is worth a long journey to see.
