of Jeffersonville, formerly of Spencer and French Lick, will have charge at New Albany and vicinity, with Thurston Meloy as manager at Jeffersonville; Ray Armstrong, formerly of Attica and New Castle, but now service superintendent at New Albany, becomes manager at Bedford and Mitchell.

Paul Quinn, formerly of Corydon and Mitchell, assumes gas management at New Castle and Liberty.

President Gallagher announced the appointment of M. L. Carmichael, formerly of North Manchester and Attica, as Public Service electric manager at Jeffersonville. Coleman Flick, of, Bedford, has been designated manager for Public Service at Mitchell.

All the men named as managers have been Public Service operators for years. Their district personnel will, for the most part, be made up of men who have been specializing in the services they will render.

Mr. Schiesz stated that, due to shortage of office and business quarters in many of the cities, the location of new quarters may be delayed somewhat in a few cases. But as rapidly as locations can be prepared, he said, the changes and separations will be completed.
