

Blast Victims Still Unchanged

Conditions of two Columbus men severely burned in a gas explosion on the east side Jan. 14 remained unchanged today at Bartholomew county hospital.

Arthur Riddle, 43, was listed as critical after a fair night and James Walsh, 29, was reported as fair after a good night. Walsh, an Indiana Gas and Water company serviceman, was attempting to relight a pilot flame on the furnace at Riddle's home, 3006 McKinley avenue, when the blast wrecked the house.
