

## Energy merger complete; layoffs occur

EVANSVILLE — The merger of Vectren Corp. and CenterPoint Energy of Houston is now official, and som layoffs occurred Friday across the combined company.

Two percent of the combined company's workforce was let go, with reductions occurring in Evansville and Houston. A hard number of layoffs was not released.

Several senior executives vectren were already known to be pa of the reduction, but other laid-off en ployees were not informed until transaction became official Friday.
